Earn College Credit While in High School — At No Cost

Ave Maria University is pleased to offer Dual Enrollment opportunities for qualified students at Rhodora J. Donahue Academy (RJDA). This program allows motivated high school students to take real college courses at Ave Maria University while still in high school, earning both high school and college credit simultaneously.

Program Benefits

College Courses at No Cost

RJDA students may enroll in Ave Maria University courses tuition-free.

Earn Dual Credit

Courses count toward both high school graduation requirements and college credit.

Experience University Life

Students learn from Ave Maria University professors in real college classrooms and experience the intellectual culture of a Catholic university.

Strengthen College Applications

Successfully completing college coursework demonstrates academic rigor, discipline, and initiative.

A Smooth Transition to College

Students gain early exposure to college expectations, academic writing, and university-level discussion.

Earn a \$4,000 Scholarship!

RJDA students who complete 6 dual-enrollment courses with a 2.5 GPA or higher receive a \$4,000 to AMU (\$1,000 per year for 4 years).

Student Eligibility

To participate in the program, students must:

- Be a **junior or senior at Donahue Academy**
- Be at least **16 years of age**
- Have a **minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25**
- **Maintain a grade of C or higher in all dual-enrollment courses**

Students may begin by taking one course per semester, and may take two courses per semester after demonstrating strong academic performance.
